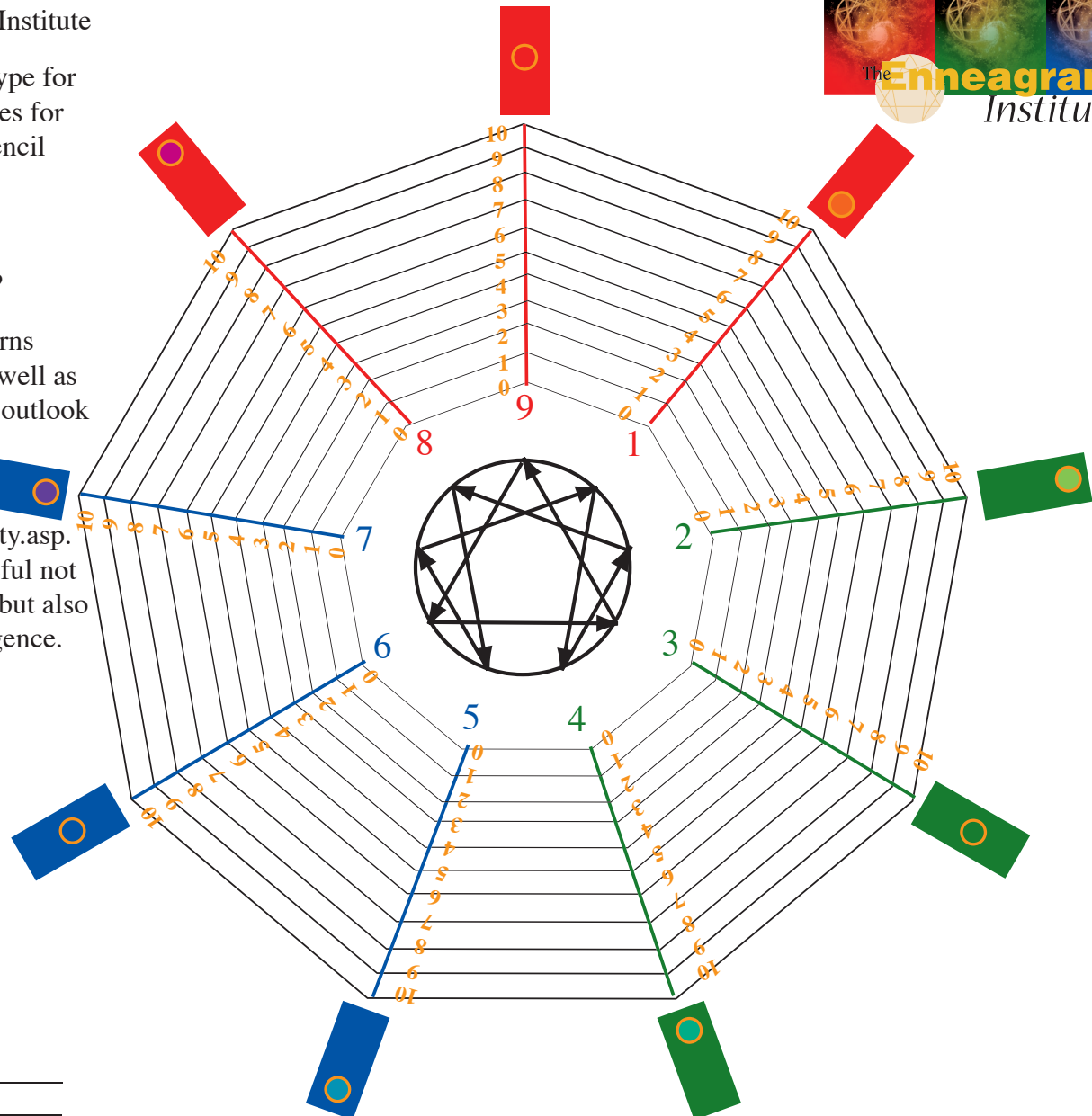


Use this Worksheet to graph the totals of each type for one or more people. Note the high and low scores for yourself and/or others (using different pen or pencil lines for each person).

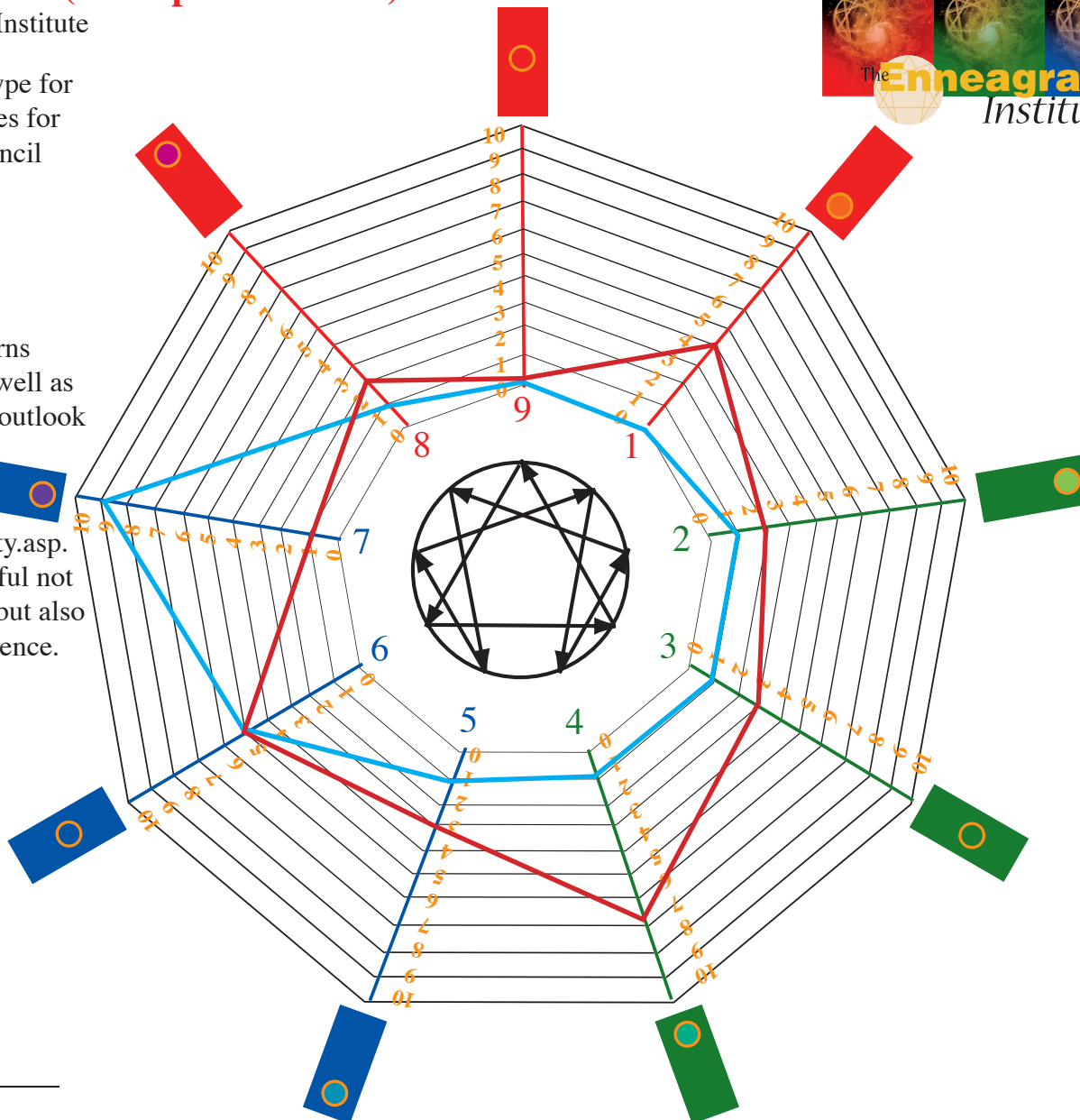
